**Resident Portal** – If you haven't already, please check out Berg's Resident Portal at: www.bergtenant.com. You can pay rent



and other charges on-line via bank draft or credit card, view your statement, enter and track Work Orders, and view any documents that have been uploaded to your account.

**Recycle** – PLEASE be sure to recycle properly! NO plastic bags or pizza boxes in the recycle bin! When in doubt, throw it out! Waste Management charges extra when there are non-recyclable items in the recycle bin! All recyclables should be loose in the bin. Please use a paper bag or box to collect your recyclables. Flatten ALL boxes so everything can fit inside the bin. If the bin is full, please DO NOT put trash or recyclables on the ground in front of the bin; please put them on the side so that the bin can still be accessed for pickup, or hold them until the next pickup so the contents do not get wet and blow around.

## **Sheet Pan Chicken Fajitas**



¼ cup taco seasoning 1 tbsp. olive oil 1 lime, juiced 2 lbs. boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut into thin slices 1 red onion, sliced thin 1 red bell pepper, sliced thin 1 yellow bell pepper, sliced thin 1 green bell pepper, sliced thin small flour tortillas, warmed, optional avocado, optional cilantro, optional salsa or hot sauce, optional

In a large bowl, make a marinade using the taco seasoning, olive oil, and lime juice. Toss the chicken, red onion, and bell peppers together with the marinade. If you have time, allow to marinate, covered, for 1 hour. If not, bake right away. Preheat oven to 375° F. Spread the chicken and vegetable mixture onto a rimmed sheet pan. Bake for 15-20 minutes, or until meat is cooked through.
