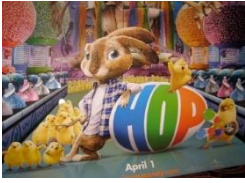
Trailbreaker Marathon

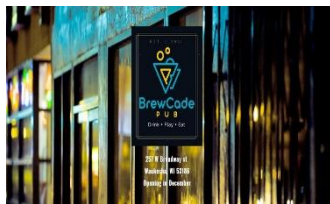

Spring Tenant Reminders



- **Safety First!** For everyone's safety, please assist in putting salt down, when needed, especially during the melting and re-freezing season. Let us know if your bucket is empty.
- **Spring Cleanup** – Once the snow is gone, please remove all items from the grassy areas in preparation for spring cleanup and grass cutting.
- **Pets** – If you haven't already, please be sure to register your pet with the City of Waukesha for 2022.
- **Recycle** – Remember to **recycle properly!** No pizza boxes, NO plastic bags of any kind, NO bubble wrap or Styrofoam, and NO paper towels or egg cartons! Break down boxes, and, if the bin is too full, DO NOT put your trash in front of the bin as it cannot be emptied, put the extras to the side or rear of the container. Let's all work together to save the planet and cut the cost of waste removal.
- **Electronics** – This year's Spring Electronics Drop-Off will be held on April 2. Check out this website for more information. <https://www.waukesha-wi.gov/residents/collections/e-waste.php>
- **Don't flush that!** All wipes and disposable cleaning products belong in the trash (even if they are labeled flushable.) Flushing wipes and other trash down the toilet can cause problems in the City's sewer system. This leads to costly cleanups and sometimes results in basement backups.

Coconut Egg Nests

Ingredients

- 6 ounces white candy coating, coarsely chopped
- 6 drops green food coloring
- 1 drop yellow food coloring
- 1 cup sweetened shredded coconut
- 36 jelly beans

Directions: In a microwave-safe bowl, melt candy coating; stir in food coloring until blended. Stir in coconut. Drop by tablespoonfuls onto waxed paper into 12 mounds. Make an indentation in the center of each with the end of a wooden spoon handle. Fill each with three jelly beans. Let stand until set. Enjoy!
