Spring Tenant Reminders

- **Safety First!** For everyone's safety, please assist in putting salt down, when needed, especially during the melting and re-freezing season. Let us know if your bucket is empty.
- **Spring Cleanup** – Once the snow is gone, please remove all items from the grassy areas in preparation for spring cleanup and grass cutting.
- **Pets** – If you haven't already, please be sure to register your pet with the City of Waukesha for 2023.
- **Recycle** – Remember to **recycle properly!** NO pizza boxes as the cardboard is contaminated with grease, NO plastic bags of any kind - even if they have a recycle symbol - they get caught in the sorting machines. Plastic bags can be recycled at your grocery store. NO bubble wrap or Styrofoam, and NO paper towels or egg cartons – they have already been recycled too many times to be viable! **BREAK DOWN** boxes – Waste Management does not have the staff for weekend pickups - and, if the bin is too full, **DO NOT** put your trash in front of the bin as Waste Management cannot properly pick up the bin.

Put the extras to the side or rear of the container. Let's all work together to save the planet and cut the cost of waste removal!

- **Don't flush that!** All wipes and disposable cleaning products belong in the trash (even if they are labeled flushable.) Flushing wipes and other trash down the toilet can cause problems in the City's sewer system. This leads to costly cleanups and sometimes results in basement backups. Prevention is better than Repair!

Banana Cinnamon Rolls

Ingredients

4 Bananas
Cinnamon

Date Paste

1 cup medjool dates (about 12)
½ cup water
1 tsp Vanilla

Instructions

Preheat oven to 250°F. Slice bananas lengthwise into 3 strips each. Lay out the slices on 2 baking trays lined with parchment paper. Bake for 1 hour. Remove from oven and let cool for 15-20 minutes. Blend all ingredients for the Date Paste ingredients. Spread about 1 tablespoon of the Date Paste down the length of each banana slice, sprinkle with cinnamon, and roll. Return them to the oven for 1.5-2 hours. Enjoy!
