## CROCKPOT CRISPY CHICKEN TINGA TACOS WITH JALAPEÑO AVOCADO CREMA



### Ingredients:

- 1/2 lb. boneless chicken breasts or thighs
- 2-3 chipotle peppers in adobo, finely chopped
- 1 yellow onion, chopped
- 3/4 cup red enchilada sauce
- 12-16 corn tortillas, warmed
- 1/2 cup shredded pepper jack cheese
- 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- shredded lettuce and pickled onions, for serving

### Crema:

- 2 large avocados, halved
- 1/4-1/2 cup pickled jalapeños
- 1/2 cup fresh cilantro
- 1-2 tsp honey
- 1 clove garlic, grated
- 2 limes (juice from)
- flaky salt

1. Combine the chicken, onion, enchilada sauce, chipotle, oregano, cumin, and salt in the crockpot. Cover and cook on LOW for 4-5 hours or on HIGH for 2-3 hours.
2. When finished cooking, shred the meat and toss with the sauce. Preheat the oven to 425° F.
3. Warm the tortillas for 30 seconds to 1 minute in the microwave, until pliable. Lay each tortilla flat on a baking sheet and rub with olive oil, then layer 1/2 evenly with cheese and chicken. Fold the other half of the tortilla over the filling, gently pushing to adhere (see above photo). Transfer to the oven and bake for 5-8 minutes, then flip and cook another 5 minutes, or until the cheese has melted and the tortillas are crisp.
4. Meanwhile, make the Avocado Crema. Combine all ingredients in a blender and blend until smooth and creamy. Season with salt.
5. Serve the tacos topped with avocado, lettuce, limes, and any other desired toppings.

### Ingredients:

1/2 lb. boneless chicken breasts or thighs  
2-3 chipotle peppers in adobo, finely chopped  
1 yellow onion, chopped                      1 tsp kosher salt  
3/4 cup red enchilada sauce                      1 tsp dried oregano  
12-16 corn tortillas, warmed                      1 tsp ground cumin  
1/2 cup shredded pepper jack cheese  
1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese  
shredded lettuce and pickled onions, for serving

### Crema:

2 large avocados, halved                      1 clove garlic, grated  
1/4-1/2 cup pickled jalapeños                      2 limes (juice from)  
1/2 cup fresh cilantro                      flaky salt  
1-2 tsp honey

1. Combine the chicken, onion, enchilada sauce, chipotle, oregano, cumin, and salt in the crockpot. Cover and cook on LOW for 4-5 hours or on HIGH for 2-3 hours.

2. When finished cooking, shred the meat and toss with the sauce. Preheat the oven to 425° F.

3. Warm the tortillas for 30 seconds to 1 minute in the microwave, until pliable. Lay each tortilla flat on a baking sheet and rub with olive oil, then layer 1/2 evenly with cheese and chicken. Fold the other half of the tortilla over the filling, gently pushing to adhere (see above photo). Transfer to the oven and bake for 5-8 minutes, then flip and cook another 5 minutes, or until the cheese has melted and the tortillas are crisp.

3. Warm the tortillas for 30 seconds to 1 minute in the microwave, until pliable. Lay each tortilla flat on a baking sheet and rub with olive oil, then layer 1/2 evenly with cheese and chicken. Fold the other half of the tortilla over the filling, gently pushing to adhere (see above photo). Transfer to the oven and bake for 5-8 minutes, then flip and cook another 5 minutes, or until the cheese has melted and the tortillas are crisp.
4. Meanwhile, make the Avocado Crema. Combine all ingredients in a blender and blend until smooth and creamy. Season with salt.

- 1/4-1/2 cup pickled jalapeños
- 1/2 cup fresh cilantro
- 1-2 tsp honey
- 1 clove garlic, grated
- 2 limes (juice from)
- flaky salt

1. Combine the chicken, onion, enchilada sauce, chipotle, oregano, cumin, and salt in the crockpot. Cover and cook on LOW for 4-5 hours or on HIGH for 2-3 hours.

### Crema:

2 large avocados, halved                      1 clove garlic, grated  
1/4-1/2 cup pickled jalapeños                      2 limes (juice from)  
1/2 cup fresh cilantro                      flaky salt  
1-2 tsp honey

## CROCKPOT CRISPY CHICKEN TINGA TACOS WITH JALAPEÑO AVOCADO CREMA



### Ingredients:

1/2 lb. boneless chicken breasts or thighs  
2-3 chipotle peppers in adobo, finely chopped  
1 yellow onion, chopped                      1 tsp kosher salt  
3/4 cup red enchilada sauce                      1 tsp dried oregano  
12-16 corn tortillas, warmed                      1 tsp ground cumin  
1/2 cup shredded pepper jack cheese  
1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese  
shredded lettuce and pickled onions, for serving

### Crema:

2 large avocados, halved                      1 clove garlic, grated  
1/4-1/2 cup pickled jalapeños                      2 limes (juice from)  
1/2 cup fresh cilantro                      flaky salt  
1-2 tsp honey

1. Combine the chicken, onion, enchilada sauce, chipotle, oregano, cumin, and salt in the crockpot. Cover and cook on LOW for 4-5 hours or on HIGH for 2-3 hours.

2. When finished cooking, shred the meat and toss with the sauce. Preheat the oven to 425° F.

3. Warm the tortillas for 30 seconds to 1 minute in the microwave, until pliable. Lay each tortilla flat on a baking sheet and rub with olive oil, then layer 1/2 evenly with cheese and chicken. Fold the other half of the tortilla over the filling, gently pushing to adhere (see above photo). Transfer to the oven and bake for 5-8 minutes, then flip and cook another 5 minutes, or until the cheese has melted and the tortillas are crisp.

4. Meanwhile, make the Avocado Crema. Combine all ingredients in a blender and blend until smooth and creamy. Season with salt.

5. Serve the tacos topped with avocado, lettuce, limes, and any other desired toppings.
