Construction will finish up sometime in July 2019.

Sweet Pan - Lemon Chicken & Asparagus
Quick and Easy Summer Meal!

Ingredients:



- 1.5 lbs. chicken tenders
- 1 bunch asparagus
- 2 fresh lemons
- 2-3 tbsps. lemon pepper
- 1 tsp kosher salt
- 2 oz. Parmesan- shaved olive oil

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 425°F
2. Slice lemons into rounds and place the slices on a greased baking sheet.
3. Place asparagus and chicken tenders over the slices of lemons.
4. Drizzle everything with the olive oil and sprinkle with salt.
5. Sprinkle the chicken tenders with lemon pepper.
6. Bake for 15-20 minutes
7. Garnish with shaved Parmesan.
