## Ginger-Glazed Grilled Honeydew

1/4 cup peach preserves

1 tbs. lemon juice

1 tbs. chopped crystallized ginger

2 tsp. grated lemon zest

1/8 tsp. ground cloves

1 medium honeydew melon, cut into 2 inch cubes.



In a small bowl, combine the first 5 ingredients. Thread honeydew onto 6 metal or soaked wooden skewers; brush with half the glaze. On a lightly oiled rack, grill honeydew, covered, over medium-high heat or broil 4 in. from the heat just until melon begins to soften and brown, 4-6 minutes, turning and basting frequently with remaining glaze. **Health tip** - These honeydew skewers are a sweet (and delicious) way to get a healthy dose of vitamin C and potassium. Nutrition Facts: 1 skewer=101 calories.

**Resident Portal** – If you haven't already, please check out Berg's Resident Portal at:

[www.bergtenant.com](http://www.bergtenant.com). You can pay rent and other charges on-line via bank draft or credit card, view your statement, enter and track Work Orders, and view any documents that have been uploaded to your account.



**Recycle** – PLEASE be sure to recycle properly! NO plastic bags or pizza boxes in the recycle bin! When in doubt, throw it out! Waste Management charges extra when there are non-recyclable items in the recycle bin! All recyclables should be loose in the bin. Please use a paper bag or box to collect your recyclables. Flatten all boxes so everything can fit inside the bin. If the bin is full, please DO NOT put trash or recyclables on the ground in front of the bin; please put them on the side so that the bin can still be accessed for pickup, or hold them until the next pickup so the contents do not get wet and blow around.
