Minooka Park, located close by, in Waukesha, at 1927 E. Sunset Drive, is the largest park in the Waukesha County Park System with a total of 579 acres. Minooka Park has a refreshingly tranquil atmosphere with trails that lead you farther from the city and further into nature. Minooka Park also boasts a 19-acre dog exercise area!

Most popular with the summer crowd is the swimming beach and pond. Enjoy a day at the beach or take a walk through the miles of wooded trails and see how many varieties of birds you can spot. There are restrooms, picnic tables and grills for cook-outs, a volleyball court, and even an archery range.

See the scenic fall colors as stands of blazing deciduous hardwoods burst into their autumn reds, yellows, and oranges. In winter, the park becomes an outdoor enthusiast's frosty paradise with miles of groomed cross-country ski trails and a spacious sledding hill.

Dogs in the Parks?

The Waukesha County Park System has over 70 acres of fully fenced dog exercise areas, two designated dog swim areas, three open beach swimming areas, and over 60 miles of wooded and paved trails to explore.

- Dogs are welcome at all Waukesha County Parks, except Retzer Nature Center (leashed service dogs permitted).
- All dogs must remain leashed (6' maximum when not in designated off-leash areas).
- Dogs are not permitted on groomed cross country ski trails, but are permitted on winter hiking and snowshoeing trails.
- A Daily Permit or an Annual Park Sticker is required for park and dog exercise area entry.
- In case of a dog bite or serious dog incident, with injury, call (262) 446-6070.

Guitar Town: Throughout Downtown Waukesha, you will find 15+ murals created by local artists and the Walldogs, along with thirteen 10 ft. tall artistically adorned fiberglass guitars at various locations. Many of the murals, and all of the large guitars, are part of the reason Waukesha was named a Gibson Guitar Town in 2012 and 2013.
