Easy Halloween Chocolate Bark



- 3 Cups Chocolate Chips
- 2 Kit Kat Bars
- 2 ounces Peanut Butter Cups
- ¼ Cup M & M's
- ¼ Cup Candy Corn
- 1 Tablespoon of Candy eyes

Line a baking sheet with parchment paper or a non-stick baking mat. Add chocolate chips to a bowl and microwave in 30 second intervals until smooth. Using a spatula, spread the chocolate on the baking sheet to about 1/4 inch thick. Press the candy onto the melted chocolate. Chill for at least 30 minutes to harden. Remove bark to a cutting board and cut into pieces with a sharp knife. Serve and enjoy!
